

## Instructions for Poster Presentations

All authors are responsible for displaying your materials before the beginning of Poster Session. You can be allowed to display at below time.

Set up: August 18 12:00-17:30
Removal: August 21 13:30-15:30
You are required to attend the sessions to answer questions in front of your poster during the period mentioned below.
Each poster will be inspected for commercialism; any overt commercialism will be deleted from the poster.

## Poster size (display board usable size)

Height: 1.8 m , Width: 0.8 m .
Please note that these dimensions may not be exceeded under any circumstances.

## Location

The boards will be numbered (paper reference number) and placed in room 315 on the 3 rd floor. Presenters should use pushpins or Velcro tape to put up their posters. Those will be prepared by the Conference Secretariat. No other adhesive method is permitted on the boards.

The Secretariat will not be responsible for the loss of the poster after removal time.

## Period

Poster presentation will be held on August 19-20.
Please make sure your paper reference number is even number or odd number. During this time all presenters are requested to stay in front of their own panels.
Group 1 : for the Presenter whose Paper reference number is "Even"
Core time: 12:10-13:30 on August 19

Group 2: for the Presenter whose Paper reference number is "Odd"
Core time: 12:10-13:30 on August 20

Design of poster


A poster is a strong visual medium and things that can easily be illustrated should be given priority. In general, the poster (Height: 1.8 m , Width: 0.8 m ) should include one-sentence statements that summarize your work. You should have one or two sentences of introduction, a brief description of the research method, results and conclusions. Please remember that people are graphics driven. It is much easier to communicate with audience by figures, charts, and tables than text. The message you want to give to these delegates must be visible from a distance of 2 m , so use an appropriate font size. The recommended size is 36 for text, when you print in real size. The layout should be signed so a viewer can quickly and easily understand.
